Preface

This Bibliography of "Free and Inexpensive Materials on World Affairs" has been prepared for the large number of teachers and others in the United States who are interested and concerned about world affairs and who are attempting to develop an interested and informed electorate which will participate intelligently in the formation of national policy regarding international relations. Most of these persons are busy and do not have the time to ferret out the materials which would help them to do an effective job of education for international understanding. Most of them do not have adequate budgets with which to purchase many of the excellent materials in this field. It is the intent of this Bibliography to call to their attention free and inexpensive materials which will prove useful to them in their work.

Some of the materials are solely for teachers and some are solely for students. Many of the items will be of value to various groups. An indication is given on many of the items as to which group will profit most by that particular entry. In other cases the title itself is self-explanatory.

Although the list was prepared primarily for teachers, it should be useful to librarians and to leaders of youth and adult groups in churches, clubs, service organizations, labor unions and other bodies interested in world affairs.

All the materials listed can be obtained for \$1 or less. Most of the items cost 25c or less. A few of the booklets and other materials are free.

The compiler would welcome communications on other entries which might be included in a future edition.

It is hoped that this Bibliography may also reveal the areas and topics for which there is now a scarcity of materials, and may thus serve as an aid to organizations and individuals interested in the preparation of further materials on world affairs.

A few films and filmstrips appear in this List, but unfortunately most of them do not fall within the limits of "Free and Inexpensive Materials," as the rental costs in most cases begin at \$1.25 to \$1.50. It is therefore hoped that teachers will supplement the attached Bibliography with such sources as the Educational Film Guide and the Filmstrip Guide, published by the H. W. Wilson Company, or the booklet by William Hartley on A Guide to Audio-Visual Materials for Elementary School Social Studies (Brooklyn, Rambler Press).

A good many items for the elementary school boy and girl are included in this booklet, although the majority of the items are suitable for high school and college students and teachers. Readers are referred to the author's booklet on "Developing World-Minded Children: Resources for Elementary School Teachers" (Brooklyn College Press 1951 30c) for other materials for elementary school pupils.

Materials have been included from organizations, information offices, embassies, and institutions representing wide differences in political, economic, and social beliefs. The author has not attempted to act as a censor in listing materials from these various groups. Teachers interested in dealing realistically with controversial issues should find ample opportunity to study the divergent views of different persons and groups through the materials listed. Grateful appreciation is expressed to the many persons and organizations who have assisted in the compilation of the items in this booklet.

It is hoped that schools, colleges, and various organizations will make wide use of the materials listed in the following pages, but that they will not infringe upon the generosity of organizations which have free materials to offer. In writing the organizations whose material is available it is suggested that the following items be kept in mind:

- 1. Use school or club stationery wherever possible.
- 2. Be specific in your demands; list full information rather than the title of the publication.
- 3. The teacher or *one* student should write for information, rather than an entire class.
- 4. Do not ask for more than one copy of free materials.
- 5. Be sure to include your exact address.
- 6. Mention this booklet as the source of your information.
